From East Coast: The quickest route is via SH1/SH6 but consider the Queen Charlotte Scenic Drive if it is a beautiful day and you are not taking the inter-island ferry during your trip. Allow a minimum of 4.5 hours from Kaikoura / 2.5 hours from Blenheim.

From West Coast: Follow SH6 to Kohatu Junction and turn down the Motueka Valley Highway and follow this to the junction with SH60 in Motueka. Turn left onto High Street. Allow a minimum of 5 hours from Hokitika.

From Nelson: Follow SH6 towards Richmond/Takaka/Collingwood. Keep straight-ahead bypassing Richmond town centre and turn right on SH60, the Appleby Highway, towards Motueka/Takaka/Collingwood.

From Motueka: Pass through Motueka and then the small township of Riwaka and onwards past the two turnings on the right going to Abel Tasman National Park (Kaiteriteri & Marahau).

After a further 2km, at the foot of the Takaka Hill, take the small turning on the left down Riwaka Valley Road (sign-posted with a blue bed LODGE sign and a brown sign to Riwaka Resurgence & Kahurangi National Park). Follow this road straight-ahead (right/north branch) towards the source of the river for 5.7 kms until you see the sign for the lodge on the right (just after a deer farm and then the road narrows sign).

We are 15 minutes' drive from Motueka.



Arrival Information

We encourage guests to arrive at the Lodge between 4 and 6pm to allow enough time to be shown around and to settle in before the evening dinner service start.

For guests requiring an early or late check-in (before 4pm or after 7pm), please let us know in advance so that we can ensure rooms are serviced and provisioned prior to arrival and that we are available to greet you.

If you are arriving on an early international flight we will endeavour to prepare your room as soon as previous guests have left. We do have alternative shower facilities in the event that you arrive before your room is ready.

Check-out

Check-out time is 10:30. If you have a late flight we request that you vacate your room at this time but you are welcome to continue to use our other facilities and common areas.

Guests without a dinner reservation

The Lodge is fairly remote from shops and cafes so please stop in Motueka to buy any provisions for self-catering or call ahead the day before to reserve dinner at the Lodge as we too have to go to Motueka to buy our fresh produce. There are casual dining options in Motueka.
